A nonrefundable deposit of \$200.00 is required to place a hold on a specific puppy. If the buyer changes his/her mind in regards to the purchase of the pup after the deposit is received, the deposit will be forfeited by the buyer.

We guarantee this puppy to be healthy and sound at the time the buyer assumes ownership. Buyer has 5 days from the date he assumes ownership to have the puppy examined by a licensed Veterinarian, at buyers cost. If the puppy fails examination, buyer may return the puppy with a written statement from the veterinarian, for a full refund. Failure of the buyer to have the puppy examined within the 5 day period will nullify this warranty. If buyer chooses to keep the puppy, no replacement will be given and all medical treatment and costs are the sole responsibility of the buyer.

We do not guarantee canine's size, color, temperament or ability to reproduce. We do not guarantee against ear mite,worms or bacterial infections at the time of sale or thereafter. However we do our best to never sell a puppy with an existing condition.

The hip guarantee is valid until the canine reaches 26 months. For this guarantee to be valid the pet must not have been bred or sired a litter. It is understood that hip dysplasia can be caused by poor nutrition or injury and that canine is guaranteed to the extent of genetic hip dysplasia only. In the event of genetic hip dysplasia that warrants euthanization of the canine before the age of 26 months We agree to replace said pet with another puppy or return of the purchase price

We do not guarantee against elbow dysplasia. We only guarantee against heart murmurs and hip dysplasia

For a replacement puppy to be placed, the following terms must be met:

1. Buyer notifies the seller promptly after such a condition is diagnosed (if heart murmur, buyer must contact breeder before canine reaches 1 year of age) if the canine is deemed to have to have hip dysplasia, the breeder must be contacted prior to the puppy reaching the age of 26 months.
2. A copy of the OFA's refusal must be sent to us if there is a hip issue.
3. The canine must not have bred or sired a litter.
4. Buyer must return puppy to seller immediately (providing all transportation and costs to do so)

No guarantee will go beyond the original price of the puppy.

All veterinary costs after assumed ownership of puppy will be the sole responsibility of the buyer, Unless otherwise agreed upon.
